### **What is “Developmental Therapy?”**

Developmental Therapy is the assessment, treatment and instruction of individuals with disabilities in activities of daily living. We help children, teens and adults become more independent and involved in their community. We do this by working to develop their skills for daily living, socialization, self-help and communication.

### **Who Receives Developmental Therapy?**

Developmental Therapy services are available for children as young as 3 years old, teens, and adults who have been diagnosed with a developmental disability (mental retardation, Cerebral Palsy, Autism, Epilepsy or closely related).

### **Where is Developmental Therapy Provided?**

Services are provided to meet the needs and wishes of the individual. Developmental therapy may be provided in the individual’s home, in the community, in a center, or a combination of locations.

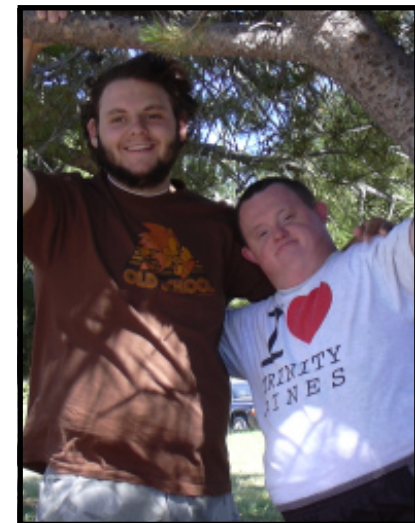
### **How Are Services Paid For?**
